

Cambridge Audio incognito

Incognito is the world's most flexible multi-room system. In its simplest form you can connect one or two Incognito keypads and passive speakers directly to your Incognito Ready Cambridge Audio amplifier or AV Receiver - this is known as Incognito Ready Type I (same source - CD tuner etc - can be heard in another room) or Type II (amplifier allows independent source to be used in another room).

Alternatively Incognito active speakers (AS10) alone can be used. These are controlled by Incognito learning remotes or other remote handsets.

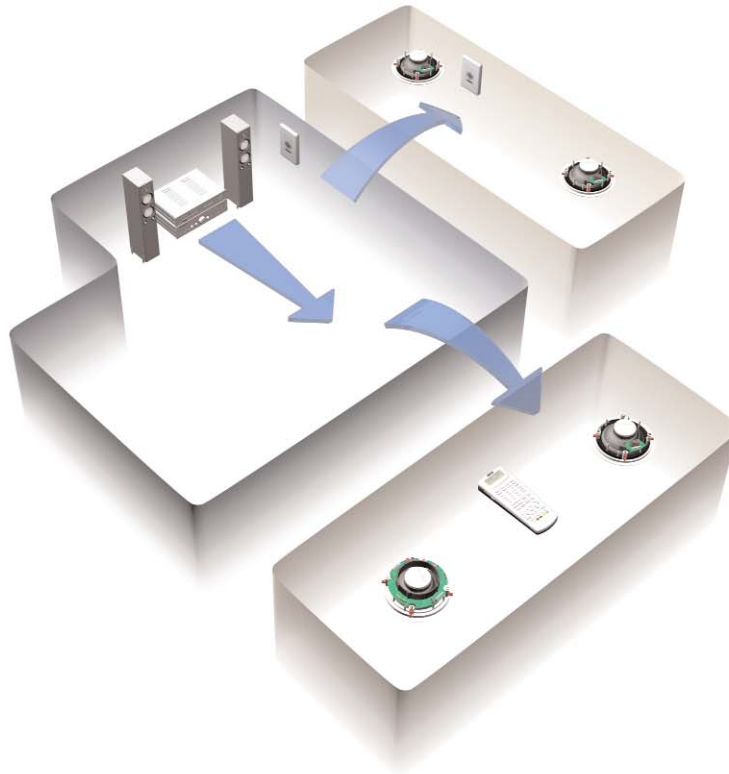
Type III and Type IV Incognito set-ups described below require the use of an Audio Hub (Type III) or Audio Hub + Video Hub (Type IV).

Type I



Listen to your hi-fi in one or two additional rooms - enjoy the same audio source in all rooms at the same time.

By installing a simple run of Cat5e cable from your Incognito-Ready amplifier to your choice of Incognito keypad and/or ceiling speakers in each room, you will be able to listen and control the same audio output in up to two additional rooms at the same time. This is ideal if you want to use your hi-fi in the sitting room and the dining room or the bedroom and the en-suite bathroom.

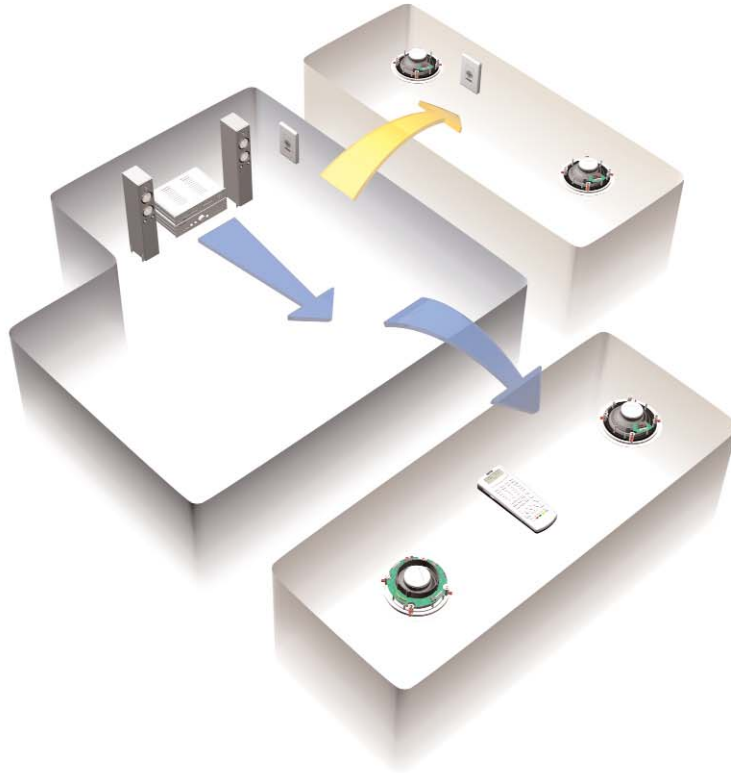
Example equipment requirements:

- Incognito-Ready Amplifier
- Connected hi-fi separates of your choice
- Up to 1 x AS10 Incognito active speaker pair
- Up to 1 x SS10 Incognito passive speaker pair
- Or...up to 2 Incognito KP10 keypads + Up to 2 SS10 ceiling speaker pairs
- PS10 power supply
- Optional extra: LR10 learning remote control

Type II



Listen to your hi-fi in one or two additional rooms - Enjoy different audio sources in two rooms at the same time thanks to Incognito.

The Cambridge Audio 840A for example is Type II Incognito Ready and features additional advanced electronics. By installing a simple run of Cat5e cable from the 840A to a keypad and/or speakers in each room, you will be able to listen to and control two different audio outputs in different rooms at the same time. This is ideal if you want to be able to use your hi-fi to listen to different things in the sitting room and the bedroom at the same time.

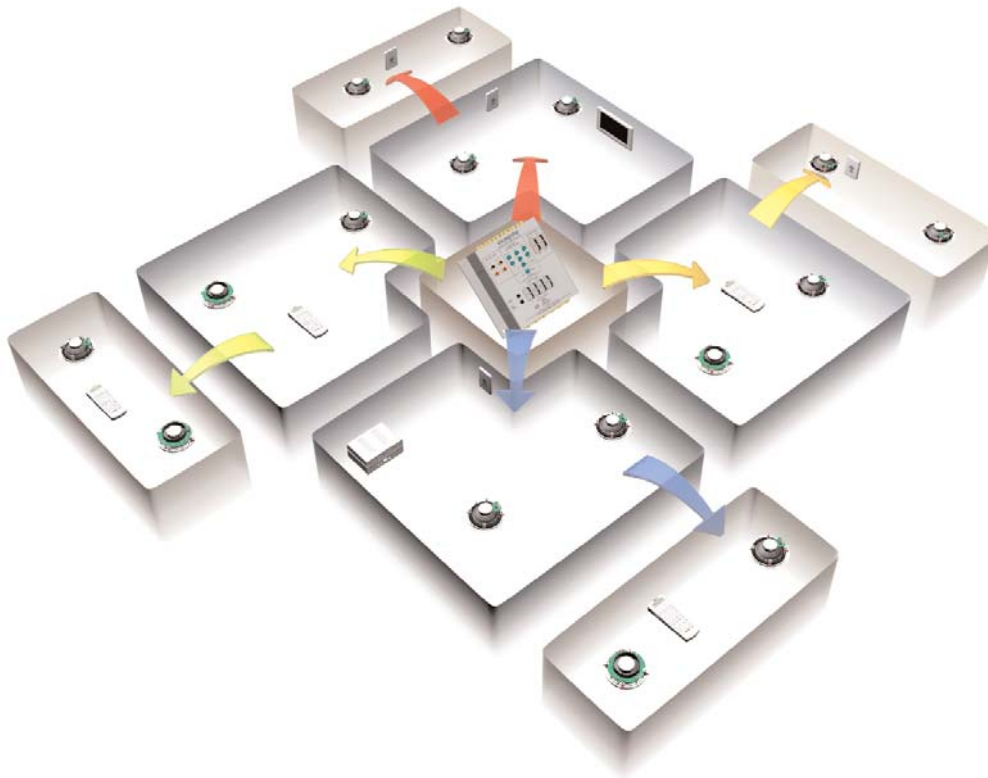
Equipment requirements:

- Cambridge Audio Incognito-Ready Type II Amplifier and other hi-fi separates
- Up to 1 AS10 Incognito active speaker pair
- Up to 1 SS10 Incognito passive speaker pair
- Or...up to two KP10 Incognito keypads and up to 2 SS10 ceiling speaker pairs
- PS10 power supply
- Optional extra: LR10 Incognito learning remote control

Type III



Listen to up to four hi-fi separate sources in multiple rooms at the same time.

To extend your hi-fi system to more than two rooms, all you need to do is add the Incognito AH10 audio hub. This sophisticated unit allows your hi-fi source equipment to be distributed to up to four main rooms (zones) and four slave rooms (sub-zones) via a single-run of Cat5e cable which carries both data and power. Each room is fitted with your choice of keypad and passive ceiling speakers or alternatively active in-ceiling speakers. Your chosen combination will provide stunning audio reproduction and intuitive control.

This set-up is ideal if you want to be able to use your hi-fi in to listen to different things in the sitting room, the dining room, the master bedroom and the kitchen at the same time.

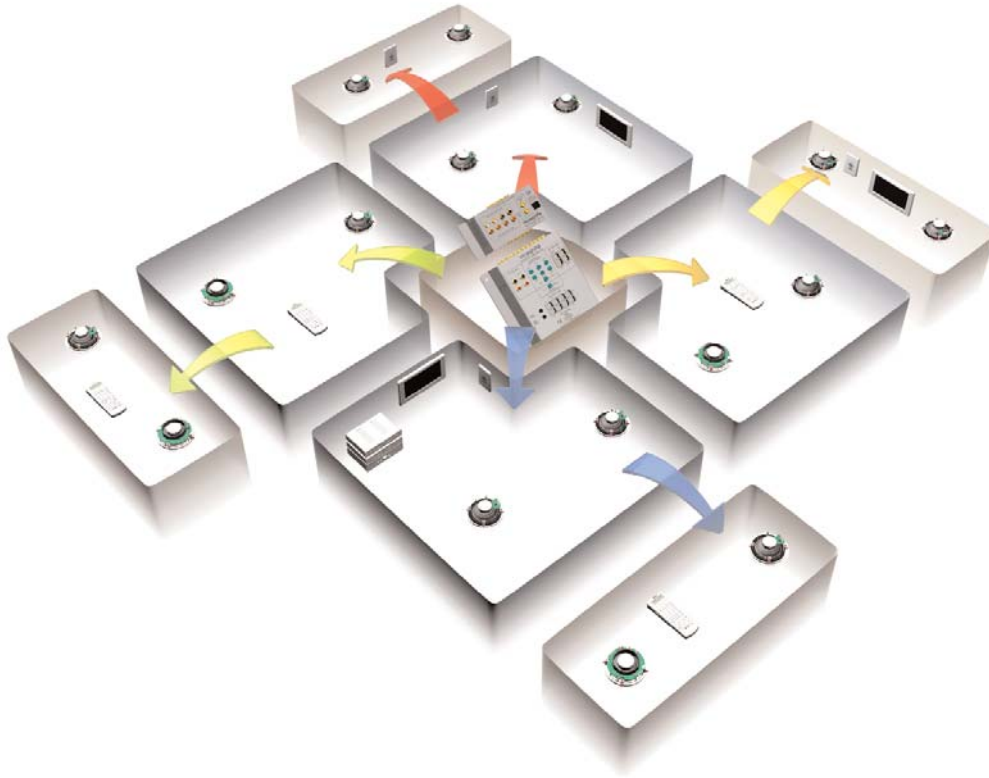
Example equipment requirements:

- AH10 Incognito audio hub
- Hi-fi separates of your choice - virtually any manufacturers' products can be used
- Up to 4 AS10 Incognito active speaker pairs
- Up to 4 SS10 Incognito passive pairs
- Or... Up to eight KP10 keypads and up to eight SS10 Ceiling Speakers
- PS10 Incognito power supply (one unit controls 4 zones, a second is required for 4 sub-zones)
- Optional extra: LR10 learning remote control

Type IV



Access multiple hi-fi separates, video and television in multiple rooms concurrently.

If you require video functionality and control in multiple rooms as well as audio, all you need is to add a single-run of coaxial cable to each room and an Incognito VH10 Video Hub to the Incognito Type III System. By doing this, you will be able to distribute the signals from and control your satellite and/or cable digi-boxes, DVD player and VCR to multiple rooms. This is ideal if you want to be able to use your hi-fi in the kitchen and the study, your Satellite digi-box in the lounge and your DVD player in the master bedroom, all at the same time.

Example equipment requirements:

- AH10 Incognito audio hub
- VH10 Incognito video hub
- Up to six hi-fi separates, video equipment and digi-boxes of your choice
- Up to 4 AS10 active speaker pairs
- Up to 4 SS10 passive speaker pairs
- Or... a maximum of eight KP10 keypads and up to eight SS10 ceiling speakers
- PS10 power supply (one unit controls 4 zones, a second is required for 4 sub-zones)
- Optional extra: LR10 Incognito learning remote controls
